Colombian youths participate in Mozart Week





The Iberacademy clarinet choir was invited to the Mozartwoche Festival for the fifth consecutive year, to participate in all the activities proposed during Mozart Week, from January 22 to February 6, 2024.

The clarinet choir of the Iberoamerican Philharmonic Academy, made up of 20 young Colombians, performed on January 26 and 27, interpreting a repertoire that included a fusion of European classical music with elements of the Colombian musical tradition.

Before embarking on their trip, they had a public performance on Friday January 19 at 5:00 p.m. at the Casa de la Cultura de Sabaneta and on Saturday January 20 at 5:00 p.m. at the Iberacademy Hall, with free admission.

The diversity of this group is not only reflected in the sound of its instrument; this choir is formed by musicians from 11 municipalities of Antioquia, who were selected through a call addressed to the 55 territories in which Iberacademy is present with its musical growth program: In Crescendo por Antioquia.

This program seeks to accompany musical training institutions in Antioquia, Colombia, in order to contribute to the development of children and young people through art. This experience is not only a unique opportunity to have an approach to the musical tradition of Salzburg, but it will also allow them to broaden their perspectives, motivate themselves and acquire tools to share and enrich their communities.
