





It is the deepest emotion, the mirror of the soul, a fascinating synthesis of the arts that moves us deeply and never ceases to amaze us.





His works include "Canciones para el incendio", "Los informantes", "El ruido de las cosas al caer", "Las reputaciones", "La forma de las ruinas" and "Volver la vista atrás". He has received multiple awards, including the Simon Bolivar National Journalism Award and the Prix Roger Caillois, and has been recognized as a Knight of the Order of Arts and Letters of France and the Order of Isabella the Catholic.

The opening of the exhibition "Women" by Colombian digital illustrator Aracelly Ramirez Vila will be held in the gallery of OpenWine Yacht in Brno. Organized by the Ibero-American Zone, the exhibition will be on view until July 30, 2024.

About her work: "My work is inspired by the female universe. I illustrate dark-skinned women. Women with long necks that breathe delicacy and elegance. Women with closed eyes block external distractions by focusing on inner thoughts and feelings. Courageous, charming, free, adventurous, and dreamy women."

Each face in her illustrations has its own story to tell, likewise, each person will see in them what their vision shows them. Her inspiration: "comes from the world around me: other artists, my family, friends, trips taken, places traveled, and various sociocultural issues that manage to awaken my creativity."


Youth Short Film Competition 2024




